2013 Farmers' Fair Queen Pageant: Farmers' Fair Queen Contest is Monday, October 14th at 7:00 pm in the Northern High School Auditorium. Tickets may be purchased at the door beginning at 6:00 pm or purchased in advance at the Blossom Shop Florist beginning October 1st. Tickets are \$5.00 for adults, Northern students 13 years old to High School Seniors are \$3.00 and Children 12 and under are free but must be accompanied by an adult.

No furniture, ropes, tape or barricades.....

Please be advised that in the past, many of the barricades and chairs, while placed in front of a property owner's residence, were placed within the Borough or Penn DOT right-of-way. Some created safety issues. Borough Council will be taking the proper measures again this year to have the Public Works Department remove any improperly placed furniture, ropes, tape or barricades which prevent general public access to the sidewalk, curb and street area which is within the Dillsburg Borough or Penn DOT right-of-way which are placed before streets are closed on Friday, October 18th.



Borough Council certainly doesn't wish to discourage those persons living along the parade routes from obtaining the best seating in front of their residence, but obstructions placed solely to prevent others from utilizing the public right-of-way will not be tolerated. As such, we look forward to a better situation during the 2013 Farmer's Fair with the cooperation of Dillsburg Borough residents living along the parade routes.
