Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: June 17, 2015

Attendance

Chairman Hess called the meeting to order at 7:08 pm. The following items were reviewed but not voted on due to lack of membership present for a quorum.

May meeting minutes were reviewed.

Treasurer's report was reviewed.

Old Business

Dog Bags-more bags are now available. The keys to open the boxes are located just inside the door hanging on a nail. Yvonne Laughman, local dog walker and Dillsburg borough supervisor has agreed to assist by checking and re-filling the bags if needed. Terri provided her with a key to the side door of the barn.

Nancy Putt gave a review of what the Celebration Church members accomplished when they did volunteer work in the park recently. Eighteen members from the church came to the park on May 24. They spread mulch in the tot-lot and around trees. They did a general clean up around the area.

More mulch is ready to be spread so members are urged to help whenever they have time. Tools are in the barn. The trees around the walking path can be mulched.

Playground equipment- Jim had surveyed the members by email regarding playground equipment that was is going to be removed from Dillsburg Elementary School. LPA was asked if there was interest in having the equipment donated to them. The general consensus and concerns expressed were: 1) at this time there is no place in the park for additional playground equipment.2) The condition of the equipment is unknown. 3) LPA does not have the resources to have it removed or installed 4) Liability concerns with old equipment being moved and re-installed.

Terri reported on minor vandalism in the Men's bathroom. Chris Flickinger had contacted Terri and sent photos showing the cover to the fan which had been removed and placed in the toilet. Light bulbs above the sink had been broken. The door had been blocked open so that it would not close and clock at dusk. Chris cleaned up the area. Terri contacted Carroll Township police and filed a report. The police did investigate the area.

Terri replaced the light bulbs except for one that has a bent fixture and Jim re-set the timed locks for the summer season.

Terri had an inquiry about a basketball court which has been discussed in the past. The lack of space and the cost prohibit pursuing at this time.

The Board adjourned the meeting at 7:45 pm.
