

**Logan Park Authority
Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: 2/15/2012**

Logan Park Authority Members Present: Lynn Sanders, Bill Cressler, Terri Hildebrand, Wanda Godar, Scott Bair, and Adrian Piechowicz.

Meeting Called to Order: Vice Chair Hildebrand called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Reading and Approval of Minutes: The Board reviewed the minutes of the January, 2012 meeting and approved them as submitted.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Piechowicz noted that he paid only two bills in February. Income consists of a contribution by Kornicopia for \$150 for use of the stall at Farmers Fair.

Visitors Presentation: Mr. Steve Farkas and Mr. John Ross, representatives of the Girls Softball Association, addressed the Board concerning possible overlap of their season with the Girls' Fast Pitch season at Logan Park. If there is overlap, they expressed their desire to have priority. Board members noted that the Fast Pitch representatives haven't approach the Park to use facilities as of this time. If they do, they must fulfill requirements such as liability insurance before they will be permitted to use Park facilities for organized games.

Sports Organizations' Meetings: The Board was reminded that meetings with the sports organizations using Park facilities will be coming up at the next two meetings. Mr. Cressler agreed to remind the Soccer Association and Mr. Piechowicz will remind the Baseball representatives.

New Business:

Park Clean-up Day: The Board voted to set aside April 7 as clean-up the Park day.

Soccer Association: The Soccer Association submitted its schedule for Park use. They also requested the use of barn meeting room for their meetings. The Board granted Permission.
