

Logan Park Authority Minutes

March 21, 2018

The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:15 p.m. by Chair Bob Ingham. The following members were present: Ted Pawlik, Bill Cressler, Nancy Putt, and Kay McKinney. Also present were Cindy Self, Kim McKonly, Nate Reid and Zack Schmick.

The February minutes were reviewed. Pending revision, upon motion and seconded, the minutes were approved.

The Treasurer's report was also reviewed. Upon motion and seconded, the treasurer's report was approved.

Cindy Self was introduced to the board. Cindy is interested in becoming a representative from Carrol Township for the board. She was advised to write a letter of interest to Carroll Township.

Nate Reid presented his potential Eagle Scout project to the board. He plans to build a kick back wall for the Dillsburg Area Soccer Club. He provided an overview with different options for the location. He hopes to start the wall some time in May or June and did not have a completion date.

Old Business

Zack Schmick advised that the concession area renovation has been completed and inspected.

Playground Parking Improvement Project - Topsoil has been hauled out and the township gave two loads (46 tons) of modified stone. A contractor will provide millings/ground up macadem for \$200, and the township will roll it out.

Spring Clean Up - Spring clean-up is scheduled for April 21, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. Nancy is the contact person. The Kiwanis will be there and has offered to pay for half the mulch. The mulch is being obtained from Tuscarora Wood Products with an estimate of \$600 for 35 yards plus shipping.

Boundary Update - Bob has picked up the telephone poles from Bitner Electric. The cost was \$2833.00. We will need to purchase rebar.

Handicap Parking Spaces - no update.

Plantings - Nancy wants two new beds mulched. Nancy also plans to remove hedgerow in the lower field area and replace it with natural plantings.

Newsletter Update - Terri prepared an article for the Dillsburg Newsletter.

Restroom Supplies - Terri received an estimate from Hassinger & Company for toilet paper. A case of 12 rolls is \$27.00. Terri also recommended that we purchase soap dispensers.

New Business

Lower Park Clean Up - Atlas cleaned up the branches and debris from the lower park. It also provided two loads of chipping for \$400.00.

Playground Equipment - Bob has the plans to put the equipment together.

Rail/Trail - Terri received an email from the South Mountain Rail/Trail Conservancy inviting interested persons to participate in a study.
