

LOGAN PARK AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES JUNE 20, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Chair Terri Hildebrand. The following members were present: Kay McKinney, Nancy Putt, Ted Pawlik and Bob Ingham. Dillsburg Borough Council Member Holly Kelley was also present.

- I. The May, 2017 meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes.
- II. The Treasurer's report for May, 2017, was reviewed. It was noted that grills had been received for the park which was not noted in the Treasurer's report. Pending the inclusion of the cost of the grills, a motion was made and seconded to approve the report.

III. Old Business

Party in the Park - Terri reported that Beauty After Bruises had held the event, and although successful and many vendors this year, the turnout was not what the organization had hoped for. They had cleaned up the park very well. She recommended that their \$500 check should be returned to them. There was also a discussion regarding the use of additional dumpsters during events.

Mowing in the lower field has been accomplished. Mowing will be done every two weeks. A grass path in the lower park was created by a volunteer at Bob Ingham's request.

The Carroll Township newsletter noted that residents are to contact the park before they use the park property to gain access to their property.

Nancy Putt reported on the progress that has been made with plantings. Nineteen bluebirds have also been seen.

IV. New Business

1. Pavilion Rentals - There was no report as Brian is on vacation. Non Profits are currently not charged for the use of the pavilion. There was a discussion regarding changing this policy.
2. Concession stand - Bob will be the liaison for the remodel with Zack Schmick. There was a discussion regarding fees charged to organizations for the use of the area.
3. There was a discussion regarding a "No Dumping" sign which could be installed at the park.
4. Softball field concession - Logan Park owns the door which was installed. A motion was made and seconded to approve payment.
