Minutes from last month reviewed and approved. Treasurer's report approved.

Several notes:

An increase in the electric bill is most likely due to the ongoing construction of the interior of the barn and the concession stand is in full operation for the baseball season.

No grass clippings should be placed in the dumpster. Please let others know this if any LPA see people dumping clippings in dumpster. This was recently observed and the individual was told about this.

DCNR GRANT

Some of the required paper work requires legal documentation. Terri will contact Karen Deibler about assisting LPA with this legal paperwork. We are under time constraints to have signed paperwork back to DCNR.

175th anniversary booth

Bob will give Mark Fitzgerald the mug order for 200. The mug will read Logan Park, Dillsburg, PA. Bob will need to pay for them when order is placed which should be \$3,500.

Barn Update

Bob reported: Window trim complete and primer painting nearing completion. Vent in the roof will have to be cut when good weather permits. Flooring will be stored in the barn until ready for install.

Table and chairs –more discussion. Idea of 12x4 size table and approx. 10 chairs. More discussion to continue.

Locks on bathrooms to be installed. When installed they will be on a timer to automatically lock and unlock at a pre-determined time. They will open from the inside.

Terri asked about cleaning. LPA decided to get an estimate from person who does cleaning for the Carroll township building. It was agreed that when the bathrooms are ready for use, we will start with cleaning 1 time per week.

Review of concession/kitchen area. Members went to this area to discuss plans. After reviewing floor plans it was agreed to get estimates for the plumbing and electric for half of the area so that it could be used next summer as a concession stand. Sam and Bob to get estimates. The completion of the kitchen that is required to meet regulations will be continued to be reviewed as funding is available for this project.

Old or New Business

National night out is August 5th and in the Dillsburg Area activities will again take place at Logan Park. LPA agreed to have this as a target date for completion of the interior area of the barn and bathrooms so that we could have an official “open house” to the public at that time.

Continued discussion of a skateboard park. Waiting for estimates. Some discussion about if Logan park is an ideal area for this because the area is not visible from the road and somewhat secluded.

The official opening of the new Sheetz store is July 3rd. The company would like to make a donation to Logan Park Authority at this time. Members that can come are asked to wear their shirts and be on hand for this opening on July 3rd 3 pm.
