Meeting Minutes
Meeting Date: Aug 17th 2011

Logan Park Authority Members Present: Jim Hess, Terri Hildebrand, Bob Ingham, Scott Bair, Adrian Piechowicz, Lynn Sanders, Bil Cressler, Wanda Godar.

Meeting was called to order: by Chairman Jim Hess @7 pm.

Treasurer's Report – Report was approved with the following amendment: amended to show correction of \$280.32 June restroom cleaning and supplies and \$349.72 which should have been listed in the July column. Beginning balance for August \$1,938.90 and ending balance of \$3,559.57. This reflects the donation made by Dillsburg Borough of \$1,156.67.

Contributions for trash barrels have been made by DYB; DASC; and Dillsburg Girls Softball clubs. One more barrel is being prepared for DYB.

Review of previous minutes: read and approved.

Old Business:

- Resident's use of park property- Jim read the letter that was sent out to property owners from Carroll township manager regarding brush being cleared and piled on park property. One property owner has moved brush from park property line. The letter does not discuss the pavers used to create a walkway from property owner into the park. Jim will discuss this with township manager Connie Flasher.
- Celebration Church will be coming to the park on 9-4-11 to do service projects in the park. Discussed some potential projections. Jim to put a list together and send to contact. LPA members are welcome to help if available.
- Bil Cressler reviewed and clarified information concerning the legal history of the Authority. A motion was made and seconded to table the discussion of park rules and regulations at this meeting.

New Business

- Additional parking: Bil and Jim looked over upper area along Hurricane Hall Soccer field. DASC is offering to stone area which Bil and Jim will oversee.
- DAA is looking for this lower area to stage work site for next phase of sewer line. This is in preliminary discussion and specific plans have not been set yet.
- Bob has acquired large stones to be placed at the corner of the lower drive way to help prevent water runoff at this location. Also large stones will be placed along the rec path at intervals to serve as reminders and help prevent people from parking vehicles on the rec path.
- Scott reported that the ball clubs have not been emptying trash cans into dumpsters which was requested during the January planning meeting. Clubs will be reminded to take care of this.
- Remainder of the meeting was devoted to discussion of final details of the Trail Dedication on 8-25-11.
