

Logan Park Authority Minutes

October 19, 2016

The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:15 p.m. by Chair Terri Hildebrand. The following members were present: Kay McKinney, Bob Ingham, Scott Houseal, Nancy Putt, Steve Alves, and Bill Cressler. Also present was Carroll Township Supervisor Brian Schmick.

Old Business:

The August 17th, 2016 minutes and Treasurer's report were reviewed and approved. Additionally, the notes of the September 21st meeting and the September Treasurer's report were also reviewed and approved.

Bob Ingham reported that snow catchers were installed on the roof and the gutters were refitted.

The authority received a check in the amount \$4,500 from Carrol Township and \$1,566 from Dillsburg Borough. The authority would receive reimbursement for the roof repairs on the barn from Carroll Township in 2017. The repairs would be identified as a line item in the budget.

New Business:

There were discussions on repairs which were needed in the park.

1. A decision was made not to install anti-bird spikes in the pavilion
2. The concession area in the barn needs drywall installed, particularly on the ceiling.
3. Posts need to be removed and replaced with telephone poles
4. Picnic tables need treated. Recent graffiti was sanded off of table.

It was reported that the correct address of the park is 80 Logan Road. Steve Alves would be responsible for a sign with the park's address.

There was a discussion regarding the potability of the water at the park. Bob Ingham would have the water tested at Fagers.

Water in the park would be shut down after Thanksgiving. Brian Schmick would arrange to have the water shut off.

Park Access: Brian asked Terri to send a proposed letter to the neighbors to him.

Atlas Tree Service – Atlas had agreed to remove six trees for \$2,000. A motion was made and seconded to accept the bid if Atlas would also agree to grind the stumps down.

Clean Up Day: Clean Up Day is scheduled for November 12. Cub scouts had volunteered to help.

Concerns discussed: The downstairs area of the barn is being used during events without LPA prior knowledge and the area is not really set up for events only in a very limited capacity. Trash was not picked up after the Soccer tournament. Bil Cressler addressed this with appropriate people.

Motion made and approved to cancel December meeting with is December 21st.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:30 p.m.
