

## Logan Park Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, March 16, 2016

Member in attendance: Terri Hildebrand, Bob Ingham, Steve Alves, Nancy Putt.

Review of Meeting Minutes- the updated meeting minutes were reviewed but not approved at this time due to a lack of a quorum. Meeting minutes to be approved at the April meeting and copies will be forwarded to those representatives from the ball clubs using Logan Park.

Treasurers Report was reviewed and will be approved at the April meeting.

The following items were discussed.

Old business

- a. Park Spring Clean Up April 23rd: Terri reported  
Dillsburg Kiwanis has agreed to help with park clean up. They are also looking to have the sign at the Tot-Lot replaced which is now in ill repair. Bob will take care of ordering mulch for the Tot Lot.  
Nancy will contact another group that has also assisted with clean up at the park to see if they would be willing to participate as well. With more people we could potentially take care of all the immediate park clean up and mulching on this one day.
- b. Barn roof – estimates to be sent to Terri for review by next meeting.
- c. Designated parking areas- Steve will discuss ideas with Greg and Bob and bring information and pricing to meeting for discussion/approval. A time line for completion should be considered.
- d. Mowing contract discussed-Terri will contact Quality lawn care to have specifics written into the contract stating that LPA is responsible for the softball field and baseball field during off season so that no assumptions are made. When this is completed, Terri will sign contract and forward to Quality Lawn Care for this mowing season.
- e. Recognition-After some conversation it was thought that an article in the Dillsburg Banner about the park and it's history would be an appropriate form of recognition. Terri will contact a writer for the Dillsburg Banner and pitch the idea to get things rolling.
- f. Update goals for 2016 –A work in progress.
- g. Restrooms and cleaning-Terri  
discussed with Bob and the others what repairs and improvements need to be done. Bob will assess and get some prices for improvements for the next meeting. The water will be turned on end of March and Chris Flickinger will start

cleaning week of April 2<sup>nd</sup> and every other week until beginning of May. If it is deemed necessary to clean more often, Terri will contact Chris to make these arrangements. Bil Cressler has worked out payment of \$65.00 per cleaning plus supplies with Chris.

II. New Business

- a. Park reservation April 9<sup>th</sup> for event to raise funds for Children's Miracle network.- Terri waived the fee for this charitable event. See attachment for details.
- b. Letterhead for correspondence –Terri sent templates to members to use if corresponding on behalf of LP.
- c. Steve pitched the idea of fund raising for the park. Terri suggested a specific project/goal for a fund raiser. This type of project would require someone to spearhead and organize. Also for consideration: would LPA want to do this solo or combine with an already established Dillsburg event. These suggestions need planning and organization therefore now is the time to start for a fund raiser in 2017.
