I. Old business

- a. Park Spring Clean Up April 23rd -
Dillsburg Kiwanis has agreed to help with park clean up. Bob to have mulch delivered Friday.
Approved cost of mulch-15 cu yards approx. \$500.00 to be delivered to the park.
- b. Barn roof estimates-deferred until next meeting.
- c. Prioritized goals for Spring/Summer 2016
 - 1) Parking-Bob Ingham estimated cost of eight 30-35 ft telephone poles to include installation, spaced with large rocks from soccer shed upgrade to barn -\$2400.
 - 2) Tot-Lot- Replacements for swings-Kay McKinney offered to research cost and present at May meeting.
 - 3) Bathrooms-Men's in particular-Paint for metal wall and labor-\$20.00

D. Walk around- Recycling bins do not seem to be overflowing-Terri will attempt to find out if Carroll Township has been emptying them. It seems that the 2 cans labeled for Baseball were filled on this evening. An email was sent reminding the coaches of Baseball's obligation to empty trash in their area into dumpster. This will be monitored by Bil Cressler who has been volunteering to empty trash at the park. If needed, Terri will contact Baseball again.

II. New Business

- b. Bil discussed Frisbee golf-he will get more details and present at next meeting.

After discussion it was agreed that this concern is addressed under letter F. of the park rules " Solicitation of any kind is prohibited".
- d. Terri has made inquiries about the combination of the lock on the shed by the Girls' Softball fields. They have asked about using the shed for concessions. Terri waiting for response.
