

## Logan Park Meeting Minutes

Wednesday May 18, 2016

Call to order by Chair Terri Hildebrand @ 7:10 pm. Members and guests present: Shelvy Moorhead, Bil Cressler, Nancy Putt, Bob Inham, Tyler Semder, Kay McKinney. Brian Schmick-Carroll Township supervisor

I. April Meeting Minutes-reviewed and approved

II. Treasurers Report-reviewed and approved

III. Visitors-Members took the opportunity to review with Brian an overview of past park projects and future planned projects. LPA appreciates the support from Carroll township.

IV. Old business

a. Barn roof –1 estimate reviewed by *Terri*

b. Playground equipment-Tot full bucket rubber seat with insert for infants. This seat is enclosed and designed for small children. *Kay McKinney reported on the price for one swing: \$93.05. Motion made by Bob and second by Tyler to purchase 2 of these seats. All in favor. Kay will order the seats.*

c. Status of recycling trash removal-*Bil reported that the recycling bins by the concession stand are being emptied. Discussion continued with Brian Schmick Concern expressed from the group that the recycle bins just showed in the park. At this point in time they are being emptied. If this becomes a problem and they are not being emptied, LPA will contact Brian.*

V. New Business

a. Additional playground area and equipment-*Bob will communicate with Emily Reed, President of the Kiwanis club of Dillsburg. Emily is familiar with the equipment Bob removed from Dillsburg Elementary and has been in touch with the manufacturer. Terri asked Bob report on the details about how much space will be required if LPA were to have this equipment installed and what would be the recommended age for this equipment. Additionally, what would be the cost to have the equipment installed.*

*Bob would like to have the equipment will be brought to the park and stored in the barn. LPA in agreement to house this equipment while details are worked out.*

*After discussion members agreed that if the dimensions will work, the area that could be used for additional playground equipment is the area that was used as a volleyball court.*

b. Use of park property by surrounding property owners-*Terri reviewed with Brian concerns about the property owners using LPA as access to install a swimming pool. Terri had contacted Carroll Township and Brandon Slatt responded that he would look into this. Brian will follow up with Brandon and report back to LPA.*

c. Basketball court- Holly Kelly had told Terri that Hal Anderson offered to spearhead fund raising for a half basketball court. After discussion it was agreed that space was limited in the park for half basketball court without interfering with parking or other tot-lot play areas.

d. Bathrooms-Chris Flickinger-cleaning person for the barn facility has reported that people do not respect the facilities and she has on occasion found the restrooms in a disgusting mess. After discussion it was decided that some signage could be placed in the bathrooms asking people to not leave small children unattended and to have respect for the building and facility or some such wording. It is difficult to monitor who goes in and out of the bathrooms.

Also -when copies of the park rules are given out to ball club team members and people renting the pavilion, it can be stressed to not leave children under age 10 unattended. But the park is open to everyone and many people use the park facilities who are not affiliated with any ball clubs.

e. Display case-Terri recently came across the key to open the display case. It will need to work to replace the back of the case. Discussion about where to hang the case. Along the front of the barn close to the concession stand windows and somewhat protected from the weather was agreeable to members.
