

**LOGAN PARK AUTHORITY
NOTES FROM 9/21/16 MEETING**

The following members were present for the 9/21/16 Logan Park Authority meeting: Kay McKinney, Bob Ingham, Tyler Semder, Nancy Putt, and Bill Cressler. There were not enough members to have a quorum. Holly Kelly, representing Dillsburg Borough, was also present.

The minutes of the August, 2016 meeting were reviewed. Nancy noted that she was not at the meeting and that should be amended in the minutes. Other than this error, the members felt the minutes accurately reflected the meeting.

Dillsburg Borough is supportive of the authority's concerns over access of adjoining neighbors to the park. Holly Kelly suggested that any letter that is sent to the neighbors focus on being "neighborly".

The Lions Club did a great job making repairs to the pavilion.

Bob Ingham powerwashed the pavilion. Bob also recommended that the picnic tables should be painted this fall and that it could possibly be a boy scout project.

November 12, 2016 has been tentatively scheduled as Clean Up Day at the park.

Barn - Bob reported that Bob Shelly signed off on the project. The roof can carry an excessive amount of snow.

Address - The park address is incorrect. The correct address should be confirmed and posted on Facebook.

Authority office holders - Bob Ingham has volunteered to become vice chairman.

Beauty from Bruises - Nancy Putt reported that the event was professionally handled.

During a walk around the park, Nancy said there were native plants. She also stated that she met neighbors who were anxious to assist with the park.

Atlas Tree Service should be retained to take 3 trees down. Teri H. will call.

"Call One" - Met Ed. doesn't have anything. Bob will pursue the matter to provide locations.

Signing - a sign should be placed notifying the public that the water in the park is not potable.

Bob Ingham informed the group that the playground equipment will not be installed in 2016.

There was a discussion on the possibility of archery in the park.

Bob Ingham also stated that the lower parking lot needs to be cleaned up.
