

LOGAN PARK AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES
April 18, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Chair Bob Ingham. The following members were present: Kay McKinney, Nancy Putt, Bill Cressler, and Chad Reed. Dillsburg Borough Council Member Holly Kelley, Matt Stover, and Nate Reed were also present.

The April, 2018 meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes.

The Treasurer's report for April, 2018, was reviewed. a motion was made and seconded to approve the report.

Nate Reed presented his Eagle Scout project to build a kickback wall, There were questions by the board and different scenarios were presented. The cost of a wooden kickback wall vs. a concrete wall was \$1500 for wood vs. \$3-5,000 for a concrete wall. Nate's proposed starting date would be the end of May.

Bob introduced new Logan Park Authority member Chad Reed. Chad is one of Carroll Township's members.

Old Business

Electronic locks - The electronic locks on the bathroom were not working and it was necessary to call Duty's to repair them. Terri suggested that it would be helpful to have keys in addition to the electronic locks when there is an event that we do not want to open the bathrooms. The cost for the repair is \$90.00.

Ladies Bathroom - The commodes were not flushing properly. Morrett Plumbing performed the work at no charge to the authority.

Concession update - The right side of the concession has been dedicated for use by Logan Park.

Boundary poles - The utility poles were installed at a cost of \$3,573, which was under the proposed budget. There was a discussion regarding placing reflec-

tors on the poles. A motion was made to purchase reflectors, 40 packs of 2 at \$2.50 each, which was seconded and approved.

Handicap parking - plans are to power wash the handicap parking area and then paint it. There was a discussion whether to seal the area.

Basketball Court - Holly has the information at home and will bring it to the next meeting.

Spring Clean Up - Spring Clean Up is scheduled for April 21, 2018. Projects include cleaning benches and the pavillion picnic tables, weeding, mulching, picking up branches and raking leaves. Additionally, Nancy has 12 plants which will be planted near the hedgerow.

Pavillion - there was a discussion on the use of fields along with pavillion rental. Bill Cressler was to call Walsh Construction who had wanted to use the pavillion and fields.

New Business

Softball - The girls' softball association is in need of an area for small girls and has requested the use of the area adjacent to the lower parking lot near the dirt pile. They were advised if they were to use the area, they must maintain it. A motion was made to approve the use of the area for a softball field for the small girls on a trial basis with no permanent improvements to be made. The motion was seconded, and approved.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded and approved.
