Qualifying seniors must be York County residents and be 60+ years of age by December 31 of the qualifying year. All qualifying household members may receive vouchers if their total combined income is within income requirements.

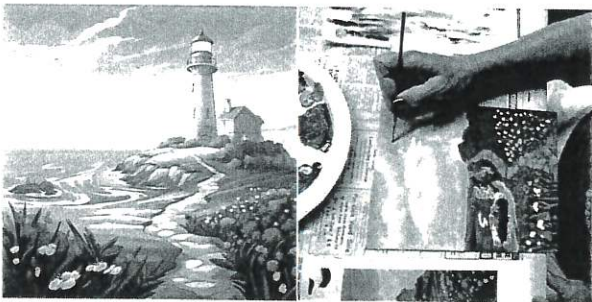
You may only receive the vouchers once per program year. Those living in a nursing home, personal care home or any residential facility where meals are provided are ineligible to receive vouchers.

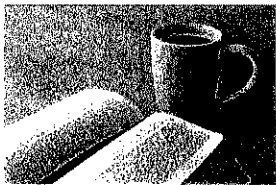
