Eat at Hoss's to support Dillsburg Senior Activity Center!

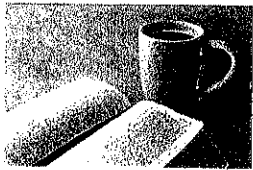

### Indoor Chair Volleyball

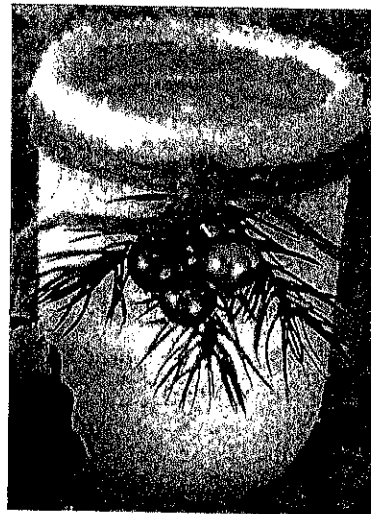
Friday, November 21<sup>st</sup>, 10:30




### **Funny Farm**
