# Resources for Those Struggling with Food Insecurity

November is a traditional time when many of us give thanks and celebrate the season with a feast. But with food insecurity on the rise, many people are struggling just to put basic food on the table.



The York County Food Bank estimates that nearly 55,155 people throughout the county are not able to live a healthy, active, and fulfilling life because they lack food. If you, or someone you know is struggling with food insecurity, here are some resources available to help.

Senior Food Box Program - Senior citizens age 60 and older who meet income guidelines, may be receive a monthly senior food box worth approximately \$50.

List of Food Pantries in York County - Printable list of all food pantries who receive stock from the Central PA Food Bank. Please call the locations for their hours of operation, and/or any restrictions they may have.

Senior Centers & Meals on Wheels - All York County Senior Centers provide a nutritious meal served at noon. They also deliver meals weekly for those who are homebound and not able to make their own meals. Please call YCAAA at 717-771-9610 to see if you qualify for Meals on Wheels.

Home Delivered Meals - Private Pay - This is a list of Senior Centers who will provide home delivered meals to private pay customers who are not eligible for the Meals on Wheels program.

# Save On Auto Insurance With These Thrifty Tips

As a senior driver, you often experience changes in your family and work life that change how and how much you drive. You should review your auto insurance policy, to make sure you aren't paying for coverages you may no longer need.

If you have retired, check your policy for these work related issues:

Wage Replacement (Income Loss): You may have bought coverage to pay bills if you couldn't work for a period of time, but if you no longer work and have no jobrelated wages, you probably don't need this coverage anymore.

Commuting versus pleasure driving: You may be paying a higher rate for driving in rush hour traffic every day when you no longer do that.

Annual mileage: If you no longer make the daily commute, you may drive significantly fewer miles each year. Driving fewer miles could decrease how much you pay.

Empty Nesters: Make sure grown children who no longer live with you are not still on your policy.

Other Tips Include:

If all the drivers on your policy are 55 or older, take a PennDOT approved mature driver class, and qualify for a five percent discount.

Always check your coverage limits and deductibles. Over time your coverage needs may have changed. Have the coverage you need, but don't pay more than you should.

#### AARP Tax-Prep Volunteers Needed


The AARP Tax-Aide Foundation Program is still seeking volunteers for the upcoming tax season.
